To download, simply:

1. Go to www.goodsearch.com
2. Halfway down the page under “Who do you goodsearch for?” enter your charity as Immanuel Lutheran.
3. Scroll down in the box to either, Immanuel Lutheran School - Washington (Washington, MO) or Immanuel Lutheran Church and School, - Washington, (Washington, MO)
4. Then click “get the Goodsearch toolbar or add us to your search box.” Or “Make Goodsearch your homepage.”
5. Follow directions and you should get a toolbar at the top of your window or new homepage to search from.
6. On the toolbar, a box entitled “I support Immanuel Lutheran” will take you directly to our homepage for any contact you need to make in regard to the church or school. (quite handy!)
7. It also lists coupons and special offers when you internet shop using this browser.
